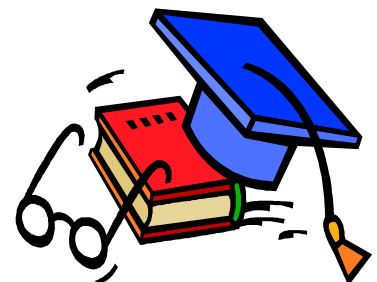
**Lewis-Clark State College** – If you’re planning on going to Lewis-Clark State College, please see the Counseling Center for scholarship opportunities.
